RIDE RESERVATIONS

Ride reservations should be placed at least one day in advance. Same day requests are made

available as the bus schedules allow.

Because the demand for bus service is great, it is **important** that a ride reservation be canceled at least 15 minutes prior to scheduled pickup time if it is no longer needed.

We request that you be ready 10 minutes before the scheduled ride time, in the same respect, the bus may arrive 10 minutes past the scheduled ride time. If the driver has to wait longer <u>3 minutes</u> they will go on without you. <u>Please plan accordingly!</u>

Fares: Have the correct fare when boarding the bus. Charging is NOT allowed.

- Wear seat belts for your safety, <u>all riders must</u> <u>use seat belts</u>, it is the law.
- Be respectful of others.
- Car seats are required for children up to 4 years or 40 lbs. Clients <u>must</u> provide their own car seat.
- No food or beverages allowed on buses.
- No smoking, vaping, alcohol or drug use allowed on the buses.
- Rides prepaid are valid for paid date only.
- Board and depart the buses safely.

- Listen to KZZY (103.5 FM), KDLR (102.5 FM) or online at Irradioworks.com for closings in case of inclement weather.
- Passengers can bring with them on the bus only what they are able to carry on unassisted in one trip.
- Suspension and/or the requirement of an escort may result if client is intoxicate, belligerent or any reason(s) that might harm or make it unsafe for any passenger, driver or vehicle.
- Client sidewalks must be cleared of snow/debris.
