RIDE RESERVATIONS

Ride reservations should be placed at least two days in advance. Same day requests are made available as the bus schedules allow.

Because the demand for bus service is great, it is <u>important</u> that a ride reservation be canceled if it is no longer needed ,10 minutes prior to scheduled pick up time.

We request that you be ready 10 minutes before the scheduled ride time, in the same respect, the bus may arrive 10 minutes past the scheduled ride time. Please plan accordingly!
